Linwood House is a 13 bed residential care home for clients with a learning disability; the home is also fully adapted to meet the needs of clients with physical disabilities.







Key features

A specialist learning disability home set in private grounds, based just a short walk or tram ride into Nottingham City Centre. All accommodation is adapted to benefit clients with physical disabilities, with an emphasis on supporting clients to retain or regain independence.

Our team

Linwood House employs approximately 12 staff all of whom are trained in the key aspects of care delivery, to ensure the provision of a safe, quality service to our client group. Full details of the training undertaken by our staff can be obtained from the Home Manager, Margaret Priddle, who in turn has completed her NVQ Level 4 in Social Care and her Registered Manager's Award, and has many years of experience of caring for clients with learning and physical disabilities.

Our staff also benefit from a vocational training programme, and are regularly supported by our Quality Matters Team to embark upon specialist learning disability training, with an emphasis on internal promotion and staff development.

Location

Linwood House is close to Nottingham City Centre, and close to local shops and amenities.

Accommodation and services

Linwood House provides for 13 clients who have needs associated with a learning disability. All of the accommodation is offered in single bedroom format, many of which offer en-suite facilities, with spacious lounge and garden areas.

Prospective clients

Prospective clients are encouraged, either with friends, relatives or advocates, to view all available vacant accommodation and visit for a day to fully experience the home. Prior to being offered a place at Linwood House, an individual care plan assessment focusing on individual needs and choices will be structured to offer as much care and support as is necessary, but with an emphasis on developing personal skills.

Activities

The home benefits from a thriving activity programme with on-site transport, allowing clients to access community day centres and activities. The home also has disabled bathing facilities and a client's kitchenette and laundry, which allows us to focus on improving and developing client's everyday skills and abilities.
