Kirklees is a 21 bed residential care home for clients with a learning disability and/or physical disability, 17 single rooms are offered in the main house, with a 4 further single rooms being available in Garden Cottage, a small unit in the grounds of the main home.



Key features

A specialist learning disability home set in extensive private grounds, based in the heart of the community, all accommodation is adapted to benefit clients with physical disabilities, with an emphasis on supporting clients to retain independence and promote daily living skills.

Our Team

Kirklees employs approximately 20 staff all of whom are trained in the key aspects of care delivery, to ensure the provision of a safe, quality service to our client group.

Our staff also benefit from a vocational training programme, and are regularly supported by our Quality Matters Team to embark upon specialist learning and disability training, with an emphasis on internal promotion and staff development.

Location

Kirklees is based in the small conservation village of Waltham, offering good access to local shops and amenities, the home is just a five minute drive to the busy town of Grimsby.

Accommodation and services

Kirklees provides for 21 clients who have a learning disability and with the potential for an associated physical disability, all accommodation is offered in single bedroom format, many of which offer en-suite facilities, offering wheelchair access throughout, four of the rooms being offered in our newly created Garden Cottage facility.

Prospective clients

Prospective clients are encouraged, either with friends, relatives or advocates, to view all available vacant accommodation to fully experience the home, prior to being offered a place at Kirklees an individual care plan assessment focusing on personal needs and choices will be structured to offer as much care and support as is necessary, but with an emphasis on developing or maintaining personal skills.

Activities

The home benefits from a thriving activity programme, with on-site transport allowing clients to access community day centres and activities, the accommodation also has disabled bathing facilities and a client's kitchenette and laundry, which allows us to focus on improving and developing client's individual skills and abilities.
