Lowfield House is a dual registered nursing and residential home providing for 21 clients with learning disabilities and associated physical disabilities. The home provides a specialist service for those with the potential for challenging behaviour and complex needs. All accommodation is offered in single bedrooms.

## Our team

Lowfield House employs approximately 25 staff all of whom are trained in the key aspects of care delivery, to ensure the provision of a safe, quality service to our client group.

Our staff also benefit from a vocational training programme, and are regularly supported by our Quality Matters Team to embark upon specialist learning disability training, with an emphasis on internal promotion and staff development.

## Location

Lowfield House is located in the North Lincolnshire village of Kirton in Lindsey, offering good access to local shops and facilities. Our on-site transport allows access to the community and local areas of interest.

## Accommodation

Lowfield House offers all single room accommodation, many of which offer full en-suite facilities. All of our accommodation is appropriate for clients with physical disabilities, with many rooms being specially adapted to accommodate ceiling hoists and tracking.

## Services

Lowfield House has developed a highly specialist learning disability service, being able to meet the needs of clients with particularly complex and challenging needs. This is a much valued service with a reputation for delivering high quality care and support.

## Prospective clients

Prospective clients are encouraged to view all vacant accommodation and visit for a trial day to fully experience the home. In advance of a place being offered an individual care plan assessment focusing on clients individual needs and choices will be structured, the emphasis will be on involving the individual to develop their personal skills, and either maintaining or regaining a degree of independence over their daily lives.

## Activities

Lowfield House has the benefit of offering on-site transport, allowing clients to take part in community based activities and events. We also have a thriving internal activity programme, with clients able to take advantage of our daily activities, some of which are offered in groups, others on an individual basis, our unique "activity playground" being central to the programme.
