Wyton Abbey provides 31 single bedrooms, many of which offer en-suite bathrooms, for clients whose needs are associated with old age and their mental state, including dementia. 3 of the rooms are provided in “Garden Cottage, affording extra space and facilities, designed for clients who can maintain a degree of independence.

## Our team

Wyton Abbey employs approximately 30 staff all of whom are trained in the key aspects of care delivery, to ensure the provision of a safe, quality service to our client group.

Our staff also benefit from a vocational training programme, and are regularly supported by our Quality Matters Team to embark upon specialist dementia training, with an emphasis on internal promotion and staff development.

## Location

Wyton Abbey is located in the village of Wyton, just a short distance from shops and local amenities, 3 miles from the Holderness Road area of Hull.

## Accommodation and facilities

Wyton Abbey provides for 31 client's whose needs are associated with their mental health, offering specialist dementia care, also accommodating clients with physical disabilities on either a permanent basis, on a short-term respite or intermediate care stay. All of our accommodation is offered in single room format, many rooms offering full en-suite shower rooms, with “Garden Cottage” providing larger bedrooms and sitting areas, for those clients able to maintain a degree of independence.

## Prospective clients

Prospective clients are encouraged to view available vacant accommodation, either with family, friends or advocates and to visit for a day to fully experience the home. Prior to a client being offered a place at Wyton Abbey, a full individual care plan assessment will be carried out to identify the individual needs and choices of our prospective clients. Upon admission to Wyton Abbey we will place great emphasis on finding out as much about a person's previous life as we possibly can, this allows us to offer a very individual service, tailored to your individual choice and needs, but most importantly allows us to offer a full social care package, enabling you to take part in the activities on offer.

## Activities

Whilst accepting that the majority of our clients will be suffering from dementia, we offer a sensitive support service to allow clients to embark upon a variety of daily living tasks. Clients will be offered the opportunity to personalise their rooms and to maintain as much choice and independence as they either choose or are able to accommodate.

We are also proud to offer a thriving activity programme, which focuses on regular reminiscence sessions and a variety of either individual or group activities with regular trips out into the local community on our wheelchair adapted Mercedes mini-buses.

Whilst we very much regard it as our primary responsibility to provide a safe and secure environment, we will encourage, in a sensitive manner, all clients to participate in all that we offer, welcoming you to enjoy life at PrimeLife, Wyton Abbey.
